How to update

Samplemodeling Solo, Chamber & Ensemble Strings to v. 2.0.1

Important notes for current users of earlier SM Strings versions

If you already have an earlier version of Samplemodeling Solo & Ensemble Strings installed and activated on your system, you can safely keep it (for use with your earlier sessions, for example), and install the new v. 2.0.1 in parallel, since both versions are using the same license key.

- 1. Create a folder e.g. "Strings 2.0.1" in a destination of your choice. Please note that this folder must be outside the previous library folder. We recommend a disk or partition other than the one containing the operating system.
- 2. Extract the downloaded ZIP file into this folder. Do not make any changes in the library structure.
- 3. Note that you can use the new library even now, by dragging and dropping the instruments (nki or nkm files) directly into Kontakt 5.8.1 (or newer). However, the new library will not appear yet in the Kontakt browser, and Native Access will still show the old version.
- 4. Find the previous library folder (e.g. "Solo and Ensemble Strings v. 1.2") and rename it.
- 5. Launch Native Access.
- 6. Note that the previous library will show the "Repair" option (because Native Access cannot find it). Click on it and enter the location of the new version.

Now the new version of the SM Strings will appear in the Kontakt browser and will be shown in Native Access.

Please note:

Kontakt can display only one version of the same product/library. To access the version not displayed in the Kontakt browser simply drag & drop instrument files directly into Kontakt / Kontakt Player to launch them.
